
SULPHUR RINGS

Physical Characteristics

Aspect..... pierced rings
 Colour..... bright yellow
 Support..... minerals and vegetables

Chemical Analysis

Pure sulfur..... > 75%
 Ash..... > 25%
 Humidity..... < 2%

Oenological Use

Properties: sulphiting of wooden vats and barrels by burning.
 2.5 g in a barrel of 110 liters
 5g in a barrel of 220 liters
 10 gr in a barrel of 600 liters

Sulphiting of vat to be filled: Burn 2 g of sulphur / hL
 Preservation of empty vats: Burn 4 g of sulphur / hL (Repeat every 40 - 50 days)

Use: Hang or place the lozenges, light, let the combustion take place in the barrel.
 Product for combustion use. The residues are not intended to be in direct contact with the wine.

EU Regulation: Maximum legal dose of sulphites in the wine regulated - refer to the legislation in force. Check

Storage recommendation

Store above ground level in a dry area not liable to impart odours. Ensuring stock is kept at a moderate temperature, in its original, unopened packaging.
 Optimal date of use: 3 years after packing.

Packaging

2.5 g- 5 g- 10 g sulphur discs (in 12 Kg boxes)
